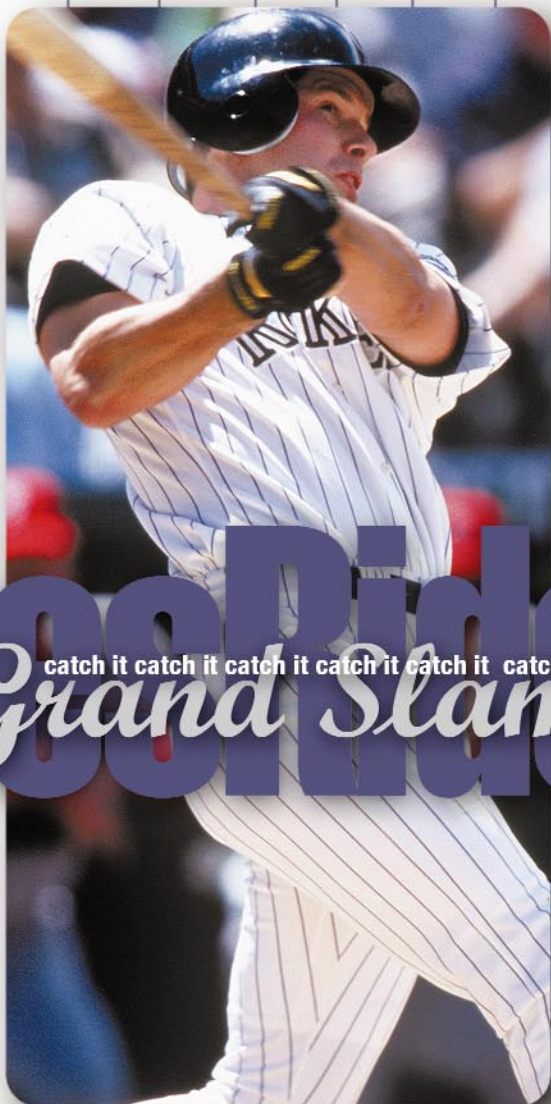

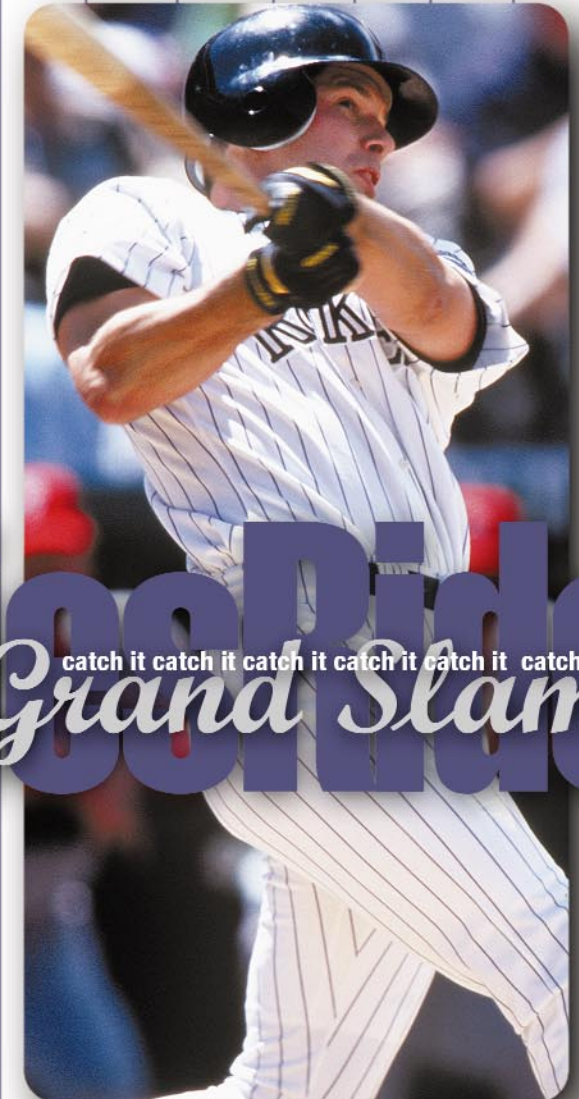
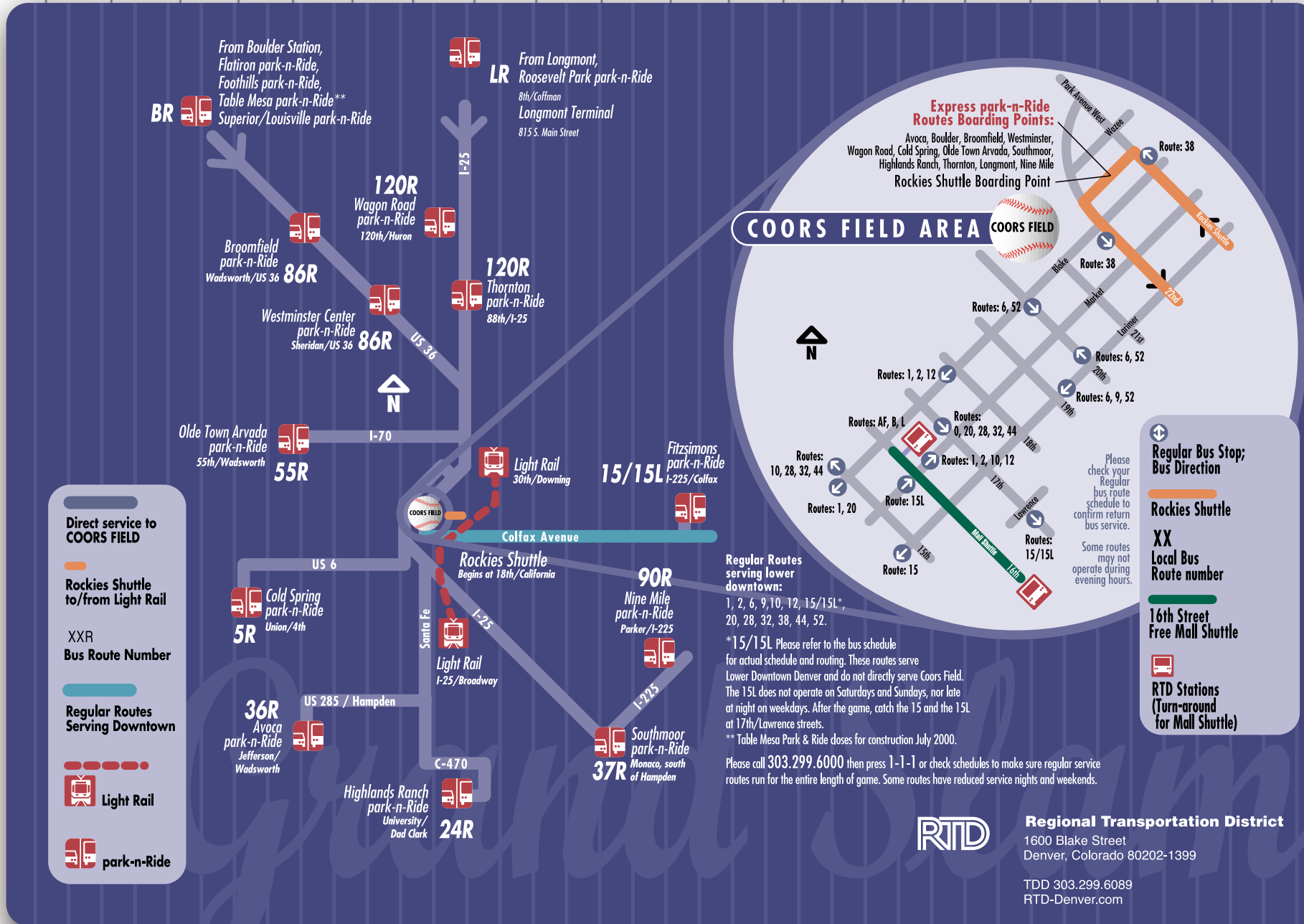

### Convenient, Affordable, Fast and Fun. RockiesRide Is A Grand Slam!

On RockiesRide, the fun starts the minute you get on the bus. Join the fans for the ride – straight to the gates of Coors Field – and avoid the squeeze-play between traffic and parking.

### The Lineup

With express service from area park-n-Rides, shuttle service from the downtown light rail station, and convenient service on local routes, RockiesRide puts you in the bleachers quickly and comfortably. It's like an extra Seventh Inning Stretch before and after every game.

### Express park-n-Ride Service

RockiesRide Express bus service is a line drive to Coors Field from any of 17 different Denver area park-n-Ride lots (see map). Buses arrive at the stadium anywhere from 15-60 minutes before the first pitch, and can help you steal home directly after the game.

### Downtown Rockies Shuttle

The Rockies Shuttle runs every 10 to 15 minutes between Coors Field and the 18th & California light rail station from 90 minutes before game time until 10 minutes after the first pitch, and resumes immediately following the game.



### Light Rail

Denver Light Rail offers another cracker jack alternative, especially for evening and weekend games. Catch it at the I-25/Broadway, Alameda, or 30th/Downing park-n-Rides, then hop the Downtown Rockies Shuttle to Coors Field.

### Local Routes

Many local buses stop at the Market Street Station, just a few blocks from the ball park. Check your local bus schedule routes (namely the 1, 2, 6, 9, 10, 12, 15/15Lid, 20, 28, 32, 38, 44, 52), and remember to confirm how late your bus runs in the evening; some routes have limited evening and weekend service, and we don't want to throw you a curve ball.

### The Lift

Not all RockiesRide buses are wheelchair accessible. To schedule a wheelchair accessible bus for your location call 303.299.6000, then press 1~1~0. Calls must be received at least 24 hours before game day.

### Peanut Fares – So Cheap, It's Like Stealing

#### Express park-n-Ride Bus Service

\$2 each way. The one-way fare is collected when you board. Transfers and passes are not accepted.

### Downtown Rockies Shuttle

\$1 each way. Valid bus transfers, passes, and light rail tickets are accepted.

### Light Rail and Local Bus Routes

\$1.25 peak, \$.75 off-peak. Valid bus transfers, passes, and light rail tickets are accepted.

Easy Street Tokens Accepted for \$1.25 value.

### Slide Home Safely

Don't foul out in traffic. When you're ready to hit it, look for the RockiesRide buses outside the ball park. Find your route number, and hop on. RockiesRide buses will depart once they are nearly full. Excluding rain delays, they will not leave Coors Field before the seventh inning.

### The Buses are Loaded and You're At Bat
